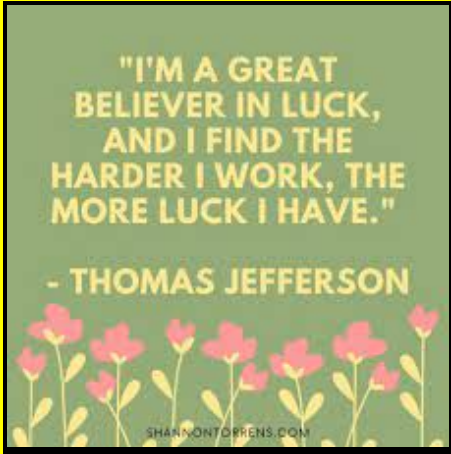

## **Graduation Cord**

Graduation cords are expressed as an extra honorable badge of excellence, which you will be awarded while receiving a diploma or degree by the college or university officials. Graduation cord is a universal award that is placed around the neck of the student`s to reflect their excellence.

## **What is a CCR diploma?**

The Career and College Ready Diploma adds additional credits in science, art, and world language or personalized pathway courses. It provides flexibility for students while ensuring they graduate from high school prepared to pursue their dreams and meet the expectations of colleges and employers.

## **How important is ASVAB score?**

One of the most critical of these scores is the armed forces qualification test, which is used to determine whether you are qualified to join the military service. Each service determines the qualifying AFQT score for enlisting in their service.
